### HOW TO DOWNLOAD CLINICAL PHARMACOLOGY ON HAND FOR PALM OR POCKET PC USING A PROMOTIONAL CODE (OFF CAMPUS ACCESS)

---

1. Read [http://www.clinicalpharmacologyonhand.com/marketing/CPOH\\_Install.htm](http://www.clinicalpharmacologyonhand.com/marketing/CPOH_Install.htm) to verify that your device has the adequate **operating system version** and **available memory** to synchronize and run the software.
2. If you are a Wright State student, faculty, or staff member, contact the Bette Sydelko (937-775-3840) to get a promotional code. Be sure the librarian knows whether you have a Palm or a Pocket PC.
3. Access the Clinical Pharmacology database:

Start at <http://www.libraries.wright.edu/fordham> .

In the lower right quadrant under "Resources for", click "Medicine" .

Click "Find Facts about Drugs & Drug Interactions".

Click "Clinical Pharmacology". (At this point, if you are off campus, you will be prompted to login using your name and UID#. If don't know your UID# but you know your Novell account, you can look up your UID# at <https://oas5.wright.edu/pls/PROD/WsuGenFindUid.svtRender> . If you don't know your Novell account or your UID#, contact the CaTS Help Desk at 937-775-4827).

(You will still be prompted for your name and UID#).

4. Once you have gotten into the Clinical Pharmacology database, click the "Downloads" icon.
5. Click "Clinical Pharmacology on Hand".
6. Then, on the left side blue navigation bar, click "Purchase Products" (You will **not** have to pay, but this is where you enter your promotional code).
7. Once you enter your "Promotional Code", you should get a message that says "Promotional Code Verified".
8. Under the verification message, you should see "First time user? Click here to register."

If you had previously installed the CPOH software, but your promotional code had expired, you may have already registered for an account.

If that is the case, you can log back in with the same user name and password. If you don't remember your previous account password, you can set up a new one, but it will not let you use the same user name.

You either need to login to your Clinical Pharmacology existing account or register for a new account in order to be taken to the download page.

**PRIVACY/SECURITY ALERT!: Do NOT use your WSU Novell password or a password that you already use for something where privacy and security is really important (such as a bank account) because they e-mail you your user name and password as plain unencrypted text.**

9. Once you are registered or logged in, you should be taken to the CPOH download page for either Palm or Pocket PC, depending on which model you have.

You will have to choose whether you are using a Mac or PC.

You may also be prompted to indicate which components of the program you want to install if you are installing for the first time rather than updating.

You should get an e-mail message thanking you for your order (it will list your promotional code as well as the user name and password you chose for your account) and another message confirming that you downloaded Clinical Pharmacology OnHand.

10. Once the software has been downloaded, install the download to your computer and then synchronize with your PDA.
