## Introduction

The photographs and catalogues of Axel Bahnsen were accessioned into the Wright State University Department of Archives and Special Collections in August 1980. They were donated by his wife, Eleanore Kraft Bahnsen.

The 346 photographs in this collection date from 1935 to 1977 and fill nine Hollinger boxes. The catalogues date sporadically from 1947 to 1977, and fill six letter size Hollinger boxes.

There are no restrictions on access to this collection, however copyright applies to use of the photographs.

## Biographical Sketch

Born in New York on May 21, 1907, Axel Bahnsen moved to Yellow Springs, Ohio, in 1924 where he attended Antioch College and began his photography career. Axel entered his first exhibit in 1926, and by 1930 he was ranked among the top 50 photographers in the world. At one time he was ranked the fourth best in international circles.

Bahnsen's first studio opened in Dayton in 1936; later moved it to his home at 117 Glen Street, Yellow Springs, Ohio. At the time of his death, he maintained this studio where he held famous Sunday morning gatherings of local amateur and professional photographers. According to contemporaries, he thrived on competition and seemed to enjoy bringing other camera buffs to a high degree of proficiency.

Bahnsen's concept of photography was that a camera was a "third eye" which allowed the creative artist another option with which to view and record life. He believes the photographer, in order to create art with his camera, must get inside the scene to the degree that all was sensed and intellectualized. To illustrate this concept, he often told an inquirer who wanted to take better photos to read a James Joyce novel or one of Shakespeare's plays. He felt that gadgetry was not the answer to the artistic photograph but insight into the subject of that photograph.

He was an artist of such quality that he seemingly could get a gold medal at will. He was a five star exhibitor in the pictorial print division of the Photographic Society of America of which he was elected a fellow. Also, he was the youngest member ever elected to the Royal Photographic Society of Great Britain. During his life, he exhibited over 2,000 photographs in national and international competition.

## Scope and Content

When Eleanore Bahnsen donated the collection to Wright State University, this selection of photographs was valued at \$25,000. The print collection, 346 in all, contains photos of Mexico, landscapes, boats, city scenes, flowers, plants, portraits, nudes and miscellaneous subjects. The catalogues include recognition of the photos Axel managed to have accepted, and any special recognition they received.

The photographic database includes the title of the photo, its catalogue number, its size, its condition, its general type, its physical location, and a short description of it. These descriptions are mine and exist in a separate printout.

The catalogue database includes the name of the exhibition, its date, its sponsor, and a list of Axel's photos accepted by that show and the box and folder they occupy. The catalogue printout, however, does not list the specific photos accepted for each show.

A comprehensive list of the "original order" of the photos is also included.

## Systems Introduction

The photographs in this collection are ordered by numerical sequence. The actual numbers can be found on the back of 99% of the photographs. These numbers had been affixed to the pictures prior to Wright State's accessioning the collection. The very few photographs which did not have catalogue numbers were left in their original position and to them, I assigned the number of the preceding photograph in the original order of the photos (see Appendix 4), and a lower-cased "a".

## Appendix 1

### Title

The titles are the original work of Axel Bahnsen, including his sometimes incorrect spelling.

### Size

The size reference employs the English standard and measures the approximate size of the photograph, disregarding the size of the matting.

### Condition

In this category, I judged the physical state of the photograph. The scale I constructed has five different grades.

Excellent (E): The photograph itself is untouched and has no creases to speak of, although the matting may have small bits of abrasion along its borders.

Very Good (VG): These photos have small creases on all four of their matting borders, but the photos themselves are virtually untouched, although they may have small border abrasions.

Good (G): The photographs in this condition have creases on all four of their corners and more visible, although still minor abrasions on their edges.

Fair (F): These photos have creases and small tears, as well as abrasions along all four of their borders.

Poor (P): These photos have many creases, folds, and abrasions, especially on their corners.

### Number of shows (#S)

The number corresponds to the exhibitions which an Axel Bahnsen photograph appeared in. This figure was determined by the number of different exhibition decals affixed to the back of a given photograph. It is important to mention that any given photograph may have appeared in more exhibitions than indicated on the back of that given photograph.

## Types of Photographs (T)

This list contains my grouping of Axel Bahnsen's photographs into three broad categories: Landscape, Portrait, and Abstract.

Landscape (L): These photographs represent natural scenery, such as fields, hills forests, water, etc.

Portrait (P): A photograph of a person, especially of the face.

Abstract (A): This grouping applies to any photograph which uses special techniques, has abstract elements, or does not fall among the Landscape or Portrait categories.

## Box # (B)

This number indicates which of the nine Hollinger "Photo Storage Boxes," measuring 17x20 ¾", a given photograph can be located.

## Appendix 2

### Description (Desc)

This printout gives my own short description of each photo in the collection, which hopefully, in conjunction with Axel Bahnsen's titles, will give the reader more information on the exact nature of the photograph.

### Appendix 3 The Exhibition Catalogues

#### Date

Virtually all the catalogues in the collection have been sorted chronologically. Each one has a specific date for its show. Some catalogues reveal only the year of their shows. Some disclose the month in addition to the year and the rest supply the actual day, in addition to the month and year.

To elucidate the sorting methods used with the amount of information supplied in the catalogues, an example will prove useful. For instance, I will show how I have ordered three photographs from a randomly chosen year, say 1976. For this year I have four exhibition catalogues which give their year only. They are listed as 0-0-1976, together at the beginning of the 1976 section of the chronological readout. Then I have a February 1976 catalogue which chose not to affix the actual day of its opening, and appears as 2-0-1976. This exhibition is listed above all other February 1976 catalogues, including the show which opened the first of February, and on the printout appears at 2-1-1976. Even as suspected, it follows the January 31, 1976 entry, which reads 1-31-1976.

#### Exhibit (Exhib)

This listing gives the title of the exhibition and usually identifies the location and/or number of years of existence of a particular exhibition.

#### Sponsor

The Sponsor usually is a city or state-wide camera club, a state fair, a museum, art gallery, photographic society, etc., which handles the majority of responsibility for funding the exhibition.

#### Box (B)

The identification number affixed to the legal-sized Hollinger box corresponding to the actual location of the given exhibition catalogue within acid-free, archival approved storage container. There are six separate boxes used for this specific purpose.

#### Folder (F)

This is the number of the folder within the supplied box number which houses and serves to further protect the gradually deteriorating catalogues from rapid destruction due to the acidity of the paper composing each booklet.
