

Linking to Library Resources in Pilot

Why should you link to library resources instead of posting the PDF for your students?

- Each time a student or faculty member uses the *ezproxy* link, it counts a use of your journal or resource.
- The library uses these counts when we have to make decisions about cutting journal or resource subscriptions.
- If you post the PDF, we can count only *one* use of the article/journal/resource. If you post the link, each time your students click it, we count a use. That adds up to many uses for important resources.
- Subscription and licensing agreements require students and faculty to use their own credentials to access resources.

How do you link to library resources in Pilot?

Add direct links to the full text of library resources to your course page in Pilot. Links can be added for journal articles, ebooks, images, multimedia and more.

- Preface the stable or persistent URL with the WSU EZProxy address:

- Select the button option to open the resource in a New Browser Window.

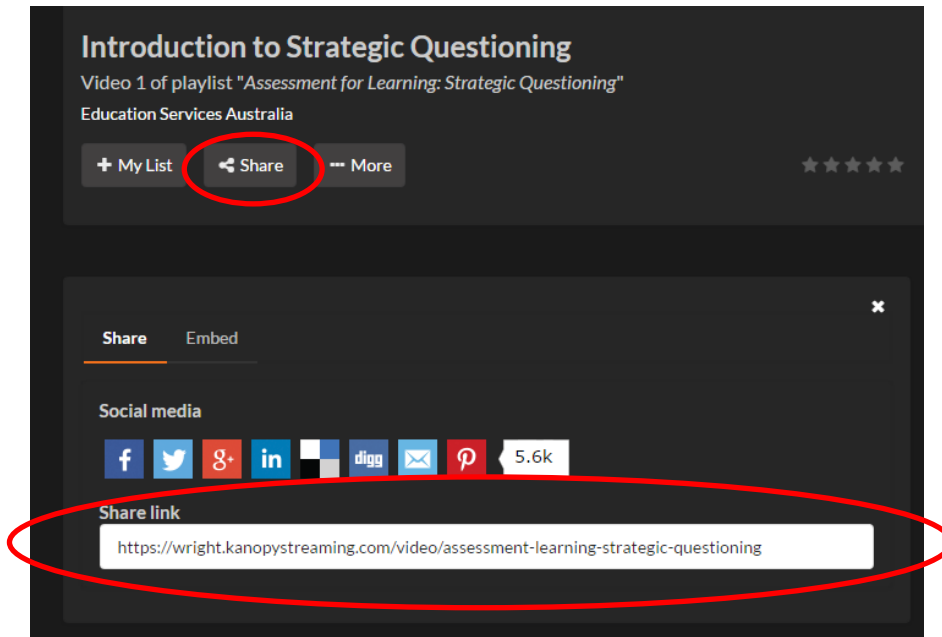
