Arrangement: The Antioch College Publications collection is arranged and listed by type of publication.

Historical Note:

Antioch College was established in 1850 by the Christian Connection. The college opened in 1852 with Horace Mann as the acting president. Since its inception, Antioch garnered a progressive reputation for being one of the first co-educational colleges in the United States. Antioch College stressed a well-rounded liberal arts education and emphasized eclecticism in its curriculum by encouraging students to study various subjects and engage in recreational activities. In 1919, Antioch College briefly closed to redesign its curriculum and reopened in 1921 with a cooperative education program. Antioch's coop program varied from traditional college curriculums through its emphasis on joining the workforce while attending college.

Throughout its history, Antioch College faced financial problems and shut down a series of times due to these difficulties. The college reopened in 2011.

Scope and Content Note:

The Antioch College Publications collection explores the curriculum, philosophy, and history of Antioch College through: documents which describe the college's coursework; promotional pamphlets; and publications which elaborate on the lives and activities of Antioch students.

Specifically, these documents include: Antioch College's articles of incorporation (1875); catalogues (1871-1934); promotional pamphlets (1935-1954); information for prospective students (1928-1936); alumni directories (1905, 1948, 1960); *The Towers Yearbook* (1923, 1928); *We, the Community: Community Government* (1946); *Reminiscences: Dr. William A. Bell* (1912); *Pioneering in Education: The Story of Antioch* (1935); Letter to Parents (1940); and *Wartime Antioch* (1943).
