

## **SC-223 Account of Wilbur Wright's Flight at Le Mans 1908**

This collection consists of two copies of a translated account of a 9 year-old French boy who was present at a demonstration flight that Wilbur Wright did near Le Mans, France in 1908. The translation is an extract from "Journal of a Child of the Belle Epoque." The journal is a manuscript of Roger Verdier who wrote of his account. Included in the translation is an introduction as well as commentary by Regis Pluchet a French Journalist who sent this information to the creator of the collection. The collection also includes copies of some photographs from an unknown source. It was given to Wright State as a gift by Mary Coker Joslin in 2009.
