

**SC-303          Robert Countryman World War II Collection**

The following items were the property of Robert Countryman, who served as an Army Ranger in WWII. Mr. Countryman was taken as a prisoner of war while fighting in Italy. The materials all stem from the post-war period.

1. *Darby's Rangers 1942-1944*-This book contains information, sketches and photographs for the First, Third and Fourth Ranger Battalions. The publication details the multiple campaigns in which these Ranger battalions fought. The back of the book contains rosters for each battalion.
2. *American Ex-Prisoners of War July, 1991*-This is a directory of World War II POWs. The directory lists the name of the soldier, their spouse and home address at the time of printing along with their duty assignment during the war.
3. A May 23, 1997 letter from a fellow Ranger.
4. Letter dated November 25, 1997 from Carl Lehmann, a fellow ranger, soliciting information about German Lieutenant General Kurt Maizer.
5. A photocopy of four photographs is attached with the Lehman letter.
