

Requirements

- Only **current students** of Wright State University have the ability to use the 3D printing service.
- 3D printing is not available to the staff and faculty of Wright State University, or any community guests.
- Printing is available on a first come, first served basis and is done by Library staff.
- In order to print, students are required to provide us with a file that is in .STL format.
- Objects being printed must be smaller than 6" x 6" x 6".
- Objects cannot exceed 4 hours in printing time.

Cost

- The cost for 3D printing is \$0.10 per gram of material used, rounded up to the nearest gram.
- This cost includes any support material used for the print.
- Students will also be charged for any failed prints due to structural design flaws.
- Students will be given a quote at the time of submission, and we will notify students if the print cost is higher than the initial quote.
- Students will be charged the final cost for their print when they come to pick up their order.

Procedures

- Students who submit a print will be added to our print queue.
- We ask for at least seven days for the print to be completed, to ensure quality.
- Only one print request at a time will be accepted.
- Students will be notified by email when their print has been completed.
- Prints can only be picked up the student who filled out the submission.
- Students have seven days to pick up their prints once they are notified.
- Any prints left beyond this time will become property of the Wright State University Libraries.
- Students will still be financially responsible for paying the cost of a print job, regardless if they are dissatisfied with the print or if they neglected to pick it up in time.

Rules and Regulations

The 3D printer may be used for lawful purposes only. Students will not be permitted to use the 3D printer to create material that is:

- Prohibited by local, state or federal law.
- Unsafe, harmful, dangerous or poses an immediate threat to the well-being of others. (Such use may violate the terms of use of the manufacturer.)
- Obscene or otherwise inappropriate for the university environment.
- In violation of another's intellectual property rights. For example, the printers will not be used to reproduce material that is subject to copyright, patent or trademark protection.

Wright State University Libraries reserves the right to refuse any 3D print request.
